Reasons to sign up for electronic giving:

- No need to write checks, or worry about offering envelopes
- Peace-of-mind knowing that the church is receiving your contribution even if you are unable to attend
- More secure than checks
- All contributions are recorded for you on your bank statement with date of settlement

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS ABOUT ELECTRONIC GIVING

Q. What is electronic giving?

A. Electronic giving is a direct payment program whereby your contribution is debited automatically from your checking account.

Q. What are the advantages of electronic giving?

A. It makes it easy to fulfill stewardship commitments, even when you are unable to attend church. Giving electronically also helps the church save money and improve its budget!

Q. How are my contributions automatically deducted from my account?

A. Once you complete and sign an authorization form and return it to the church, the contribution amount you specify will automatically be transferred from your bank account to the church's accounts as specified by you.

Q. Is electronic giving risky?

A. It's less risky than writing checks or bringing cash to church. Electronic contributions cannot be lost, stolen or destroyed and have an extremely high rate of accuracy.

Q. If I do not write checks, how do I keep my checkbook balance straight?

A. Since your contribution is made at pre-established time, you simply record it in your check register on the appropriate date. Electronic contributions are also recorded for you on your bank statement.

Q. What if I try electronic giving and don't like it?

A. You can cancel your authorization by notifying the church at any time.
